Important Reminders FOR ALL PARENTS:

From September we will be asking new-to-Reception parents to buy a back pack instead of the reading book bag. The bag below is available from our online provider.

The make-believe mystery surrounds the Scouts' tents, which have disappeared. The Scout Group leaders are asking for help to uncover the tents' whereabouts, following the directions and solving clues.

Clues are hidden around town, along a 2km walking route that anyone can join.
