This week.....

We have been working on 'The Gingerbread Man' and 'The Little Red Hen.'

We have discussed recipes and then followed a recipe to make our own Gingerbread men.

We have also written 'sorry' letters to the Gingerbread man

In phonics we continued to practise blending and segmenting. Some children are starting to read simple captions made up of decodable words and HF words.

In maths, we have been working on things that we measure. So far, we have talked about things we need to weigh and why. We have also been finding objects that are bigger or smaller.
